NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Mosaic Fertilizer LLC-Faustina Facility P20230274** – Represented by Daniel Wascon. Mosaic is proposing to install up to eight geotechnical soil borings and/or cone penetrometer test (CPT) borings. The exact number of borings to be installed will be determined by field conditions and project’s needs. A licensed Louisiana drilling contractor will install the borings. The geotechnical soil borings will be installed by an ATV-mounted drill rig with a diameter of 4 inches to an approximate depth of 6, and 120 feet below ground surface (ft bgs). The CPT borings will be advanced using an ATV-mounted drill rig to push the 2-inch CPT to an approximate depth of 120 ft bgs. One soil boring and one CPT boring will be installed in the batture to a maximum depth of 120 ft bgs. Upon completion of each boring, the resulting boreholes will be grouted to the ground surface with a thick cement-bentonite mixture.
